Mr. Bergin called the meeting to order at 7:06 p.m.

### **Motions**

- Mr. Bergin made a motion to donate the **1980 Chevy Pumper Truck** to the Fire Association. Mr. Rice seconded, motion carries.
- Mr. Bergin made a motion to open the **Annual Town Meeting Warrant** at 7:50 p.m. The warrant will be closed on June 1, 2010 at 7:00 p.m. Mr. Rice seconded, motion carries.
- Mr. Bergin made a motion to accept the **Minutes of May 18, 2010** as written. Mr. Rice seconded, motion carries.

### **Miscellaneous**

There was a brief discussion on the Atrium Roof at Quabbin Middle/High School.

Shirley Gould contacted Mr. Bergin, expressing an interest in using the Historical Museum and the Brick Schoolhouse for Geo-Caching. After a brief discussion, the board unanimously agreed to allow Geo-Caching at historical sites in town, but not in or around historical buildings.

The board agreed to send a letter to the Oakham Board of Health reminding them to use town counsel as sparingly as possible and that all correspondence must be done through town email. Due to the amended Public Records Law, personal email should not be used at all for town business. Mr. Bergin abstained.
