#### **Miscellaneous**

- \* Shirley McAfee is represented by Scientific Consultant Robert Fournier. Mr. Fournier stated to the board that he is still waiting for the Conservation Commission to honor his Public Records Request. Lucy Tessnau, member of the Conservation Commission said she has complied with the Public Records Request. After a brief discussion, both parties agreed to sit down at a convenient time and review the 100 page notice of intent regarding the McAfee property.
- \* Chief Haapakoski informed the board he obtained three quotes for lettering the new cruiser however; he does not feel he has the funds in his budget at the present time to do so. The chief had the 2003 K-9 cruiser evaluated at Lamoureux Ford and was told it would cost in excess of \$2600 to repair and due to the high mileage the vehicle is worth under \$5000. The chief felt he should keep his cruiser, a 2000 Ford Crown Victoria, because it has less mileage than the K-9 car.
- \* Chief Haapakoski also informed the board that he has been interviewing applicants to work part-time for the police department.
